Stonedale Shiraz 2010

South Africa, Robertson, 14%, Spicy, Medium body

A soft and appealing red with ripe berry fruits, a touch of pepper and a hint of toasty oak. The palate is supple, well balanced and concentrated.

Rioja Tempranillo 2010

Spain, Rioja, 13.5%, Robust, Full body

A vibrant, unoaked and supple red, made exclusively from Tempranillo grapes grown in the dry Baja region of Rioja. This plummy, soft seductive wine exhibits typical Tempranillo character of red fruits and liquorice and finishes soft and rounded.

Los Caminos Merlot 2009

Chile, Colchagua Valley, 14%, Smooth, Medium body

This easy drinking red wine is a distinguished and vibrantly fruity Merlot, It is produced in the cool climate of Colchagua Valley, considered one of Chile's best regions for this variety. The palate is rich with black cherry and plum flavors with a hint of mineral character and soft, rounded structure.

Half Bottles

Château Beaumont Cru Bourgeois Supérieur 2006

Half btl 18.00

France, Bordeaux, 12.5%, Robust, Medium Body

Dusky cassis fruit, with notes of morello cherry and a gentle touch of spice. On the palate, this is an effortlessly balanced wine, with fine tannins and a rich, almost creamy, mouth feel. Dark berry and hedgerow fruit come through, as well as a hint of vanilla on the finish. Drink alongside roast beef for a classic combination

European Whites

Pinot Grigio San Antonio 2010

btl 15.95

Italy, Veneto, 12%, Dry

A clean, fresh and well balanced white with a delicate aroma, which complements the subtle apple and pear flavours. An easy drinking young wine.

Duc de Chapelle Sauvignon Blanc 2010

btl 15.95

France, Comte Tolosan, 12%, Bone dry

Our favourite house white, bursting with elderflower and lively fresh acidity. Hints of gooseberry and grapefruit flavours develop on a well balanced palate.

Pinot Grigio Boira `Organic` 2009

btl 17.50

Veneto, Italy, 12%, Dry

This well-balanced Pinot Grigio from the Veneto region of northern Italy is made from low yielding organic vineyards, which contribute intensity and ripeness. It has floral aromas of acacia and honeysuckle, white peach flavours and a fresh lemony finish.

De Feudis Verdeca 2009

btl 17.00

Italy, Puglia, 13%, Dry

You may not have heard of this but it is a great wine for the price. Brilliant gold in colour, with an attractive nose of exotic fruits, flowers and a touch of honey. Rich and voluptuous on the palate with a refreshing and clean finish.

Domaine de Pennautier Viognier 2010

btl 19.00

France, Languedoc, 12.5% Dry

Very intense nose, dominated by aromas of fresh peach, passion fruit and floral notes of lime and roses. Excellent balance, vivid and smooth, developing a range of citrus flavors on the palate.

Chablis Domaine N & G Fevre 2009

btl 29.00

France, Chablis, 12.5%, Bone dry

Fantastic Chablis from a top producer, the nose is intense with pear and citrus aromas supported by a very distinct minerality. The palate is intense, but well balanced with a good acidity.

Albarino Condes de Albarei 2010

btl 24.00

Spain, Galicia, 12.5%, Dry

The Albariño is a long time favourite of ours before it became fashionable, and the producers have created a fresh elegant young wine with a developing floral bouquet and peach flavours. Fantastic with seafood, this wine is similar in style to that of Chablis.

Sancerre `les Longues Fins` Domaine Andre Neveu 2010

btl 32.95

France, Central Vineyards, 12.5%, Dry

This single vineyard Sancerre is a typical French Sauvignon Blanc, much more mineral in style than Astrolabe Sauvignon Blanc. Intense flavours of gooseberries and blackcurrant leaves linger on the finish. Beautiful food wine.

New World Whites

Los Caminos 'unoaked' Chardonnay 2010

btl 15.25

Chile, Colchagua Valley, 13.5%, Off-dry

A surprisingly concentrated nose of pineapple and mango combined with citrus. A fresh wine with a good structure, balanced by crisp acidity.

Backsberg Chenin Blanc 2010

btl 15.95

South Africa, Paarl, 14.5% Dry

Sourced from the Western Cape, this fantastic example has ripe fruit, tempered by finely balanced acidity to give a mouth filling, yet refreshing palate, which has a lingering finish. This wine comes from a Carbon Neutral vineyard

Astrolabe Sauvignon Blanc 2009

btl 23.00

New Zealand, Marlborough, 13%, Dry

The best Sauvignon Blanc in the world 2008 as decided by the IWSC....

Simon Hackett 'Brightview' Chardonnay 2009

btl 23.00

Australia, Barossa Valley, 13.5%, Dry

With a fuller and rounder body compared to that of the Chablis, this new world example of the same grape has a complex array of flavours.

Peach and honeydew melon on the palate with a balanced oak integration and creamy toffee hints in the background. Delicious!

Astrolabe Kekerengu Sauvignon Blanc 2010

btl 32.00

New Zealand,

Sourced from a single vineyard in Kekerengu, the wine shows aromas of currant leaf, gooseberry and lime. On the palate it is medium bodied with flinty, almost salty notes.

Mt Difficulty Pinot Gris 2010

btl 26.00

South Island, Central Otago

A fruit cocktail of aromas on the nose including white pear, passionfruit and melon. Repeats on the palate leading to a lovely rich, textured and off dry finish.

Tregonwell's Cellar

Chablis 1er Cru 'Fourchaume' Domaine N & G Fevre 2007

btl 45.00

France, Chablis, 13%, Dry

This premier cru Chablis originates from vineyards situated on long slopes facing the sunrise, allowing the sun to warm the soil for as long as possible. Long and rich, with fruity flavours and mineral notes and a lovely smooth rounded finish. This is top notch unoaked chardonnay...

Pouilly Fuisse 'Vieilles Vignes' Domaine Auvigue 2007

btl 55.00

France, Maconnais, 13%, Dry

This small domaine in the village of Pouilly Fuissé produces Chardonnay of the highest quality. It is rich with mineral flavours while a brief maturation in wooden cask adds spice and complexity. Delicious rich ripe flavours capture this classic terroir. Voted IWSC best white wine 2006.

Chassagne Montrachet Domaine Philippe Colin 2006

btl 65.00

France, Burgundy, 13%, Dry

This commune in Burgundy is home to the most expensive whites in the world. This Chassagne Montrachet is produced from old Chardonnay vines to yield lovely rich, hazelnut and honey aromas and intense supple palate matched natural acidity and the subtle influence of new oak.

Meursault 1er Cru 'Les Genevrières' Domaine Jobard 2004

btl 85.00

France, Burgundy, 13%, Dry

The Domaine Jobard is one of the great Domaines of Meursault, cultivating a collection of village and 1er Cru vineyards on 5 of Meursault's prime sites. All vineyards are worked by Francois Jobard with the same meticulous attention extended to calm and careful treatment in a particularly deep, cold cellar. This 1er Cru is a firm and deeply complex Meursault, slowly evolving and blossoming into a fabulously rich and bemusing wine. There is a captivating bouquet of toasted hazelnut, candied peel and orange blossom, yet there is elegance and intensity on the palate with sublime honeyed richness

European Reds

Rioja Tempranillo 2010

btl 16.50

Spain, Rioja, 13.5%, Robust, Full body

A vibrant, unoaked and supple red, made exclusively from Tempranillo grapes grown in the dry Baja region of Rioja. This plummy, soft seductive wine exhibits typical Tempranillo character of red fruits and liquorice and finishes soft and rounded.

Sangiovese Boira `Organic` 2009

btl 17.50

Central, Marche, 13%, Juicy, Medium Body

This is the grape variety predominantly used in Chianti. Rich ruby colour, the aroma is laden with stone fruit and brambles. The palate is smooth and balanced with plum overtones. Silky tannins give firm structure with a lengthy finish on the palate.

Azabache Rioja Crianza 2007

btl 18.00

Spain, Rioja, 13%, Smooth, Medium body

A well balanced Rioja with a soft seductive character, made to emphasise the fruit characteristics of the grapes. Packed with flavour, the wine has gained complexity from its one year in oak casks.

Ribera del Duero Oak Aged Tempranillo 2008

btl 23.00

Spain, Castilla Leon, 13.5%, Medium

If you like Rioja, you should like this as it uses one of the main varieties of Rioja, Tempranillo. It is red cherry color with a ruby rim, the nose is scented with floral notes and aromas of wood, berries, hints of vanilla and liquorice. Rounded and complex on the palate with a long finish.

Chateau Peybonhomme les Tours `Organic` 2007

btl 26.00

Bordeaux, Cotes de Blaye, France, 13%, Smooth, Medium bodied

Situated on the right bank of the Gironde on the best limestone and clay soils of Blaye, this is Bordeaux`s most extensive organic vineyard. This wine has a palate of ripe red berries with a core of minerality. Fantastic with red meats.

Mercurey `Domaine de la Croix Jacquet` Faiveley 2006

btl 36.95

Burgundy, Chalonnaise, France, 13%, Smooth, Medium bodium

Domaines Faiveley are one of Burgundy`s largest and arguably finest estates. This delicious red is made from 100 % Pinot Noir and displays fleshy cherry and blackcurrant flavours, beautifully balanced with smooth tannins and a hint of minerality.

Ramon Bilbao Gran Reserva Rioja 2004

btl 32.00

Rioja, Spain

Harvested from old vines in the vineyards around Haro, the wine is aged for 30 months in American oak casts, followed by a further 36 months ageing in the cellar. Deep ruby red, bonfire aromas are followed by stewed fruit and spices on the palate. Well structured and harmonious on the finish.

New World Reds

Stonedale Shiraz 2010

btl 15.95

South Africa, Robertson, 14%, Spicy, Medium body

A soft and appealing red with ripe berry fruits, a touch of pepper and a hint of toasty oak. The palate is supple, well balanced and concentrated.

Los Caminos Merlot 2009

btl 15.95

Chile, Colchagua Valley, 14%, Smooth, Medium body

This easy drinking red wine is a distinguished and vibrantly fruity Merlot, It is produced in the cool climate of Colchagua Valley, considered one of Chile's best regions for this variety. Es Vino Malbec 2009

Argentina, Mendoza, 13.5%, Robust, Full bodied

Aromas of intense ripe fruit, cherries, blackberries, blueberries, and fresh plums, combined with spicy and floral hints. A wine of good concentration with a long aftertaste.

La Playa Carmenere `Reserve` 2009

btl 17.95

Chile, Colchagua Valley, 14%, Robust, Full Bodied

Originally mistaken by the Chileans as Merlot, it has become the country's signature grape variety. This premium oak reserve Carmenere delivers rich jam fruit flavours on the palate with hints of chocolate and a velvet finish.

Alpataco Pinot Noir 2008

btl 19.95

Argentina, Patagonia, 14.5%, Juicy, Medium body

In Argentina's southern most wine producing region, the Pinot Noir grape thrives on the cool climate achieved at altitude. A fragrant wine with a pure nose of summer red fruits and cherry aromas. It is an elegant and well structured wine with a long finish.

Tres Palacios `Reserve` Cabernet Sauvignon 2008

btl 18.95

Chile, Maipo Valley 13.5%, Robust, Medium body

An excellent example of a reserve wine from a family run vineyard in Chile. In the mouth; a hint of sweetness with red fruit and some spiciness. Soft and delicate, this wine is well structured but with soft tannins achieved from a good balance between fruit and French oak.

Backsberg Merlot 2008

btl 22.00

South Africa, Paarl, 14.5%, Smooth, Medium bodied

Developing well in the South African climate, this popular varietal has a huge concentration of fruit. Aromas of raspberry and plums precede smokey savoury oak flavours to create a full-bodied red with velvety soft tannins.

Tregonwell's Cellar

Chateau Batailley 5ème Cru Classe 2004

btl 57.00

France, Medoc-Pauillac, 12.5%, Robust, Medium body

A superb property situated within the famous commune of Pauillac in the heart of the Médoc. The gravelly vineyard supports two thirds Cabernet Sauvignon to one third Merlot combining to provide an aristocratic, succulent and ripe wine.

Chateauneuf du Pape Chateau du Beaucastel 2004

btl 78.95

France, Rhone Valley, 14%, Robust, Medium body

One of the best known wines in the world and this is what Robert Parker said in Feb 2007 - "One of the great successes of the vintage and certainly better than their 2003 is Beaucastel's 2004 Chateauneuf du Pape. Deep ruby/purple in color with loads of liquorice, smoked game, black cherry and blackberry fruit, along with incense and truffle, the wine has fabulous richness, high tannin, medium to full body, and beautiful length, richness, and purity. This is a beauty and one of the vintage's finest wines. Give it 4-6 years of bottle age and drink it over the next 25+ years. It has the potential to be one of the longest-lived Chateauneuf du Papes of the vintage." 93+ points.

Vosne Romanee 1er cru `Les Chaumes` Domaine Jean Tardy 2004

btl 85.00

France, Burgundy, 13%, Robust, Medium Body

Red Burgundy at its very finest, this is a superb domain run with passion and a real hands on approach by Jean and his son Guillaume. Using a natural cultivation on this 2 acre plot delivers very low yields and when combined with traditional winemaking and 18 months oak ageing this produces a classic Vosnee. Medium red in colour, this smooth bodied wine shows deep concentration typical of old vines, resulting in both the aroma and palate being rich and well constructed but finishing long and intense in the mouth

Rosé

Pinot Grigio San Antonio 2009

btl 14.50 125 ml 4.00 175ml 4.50 250ml 5.25

Italy, Veneto, 12%, Dry

Produced west of much of Italy's commercial rose wines, Il Barco Ramato is a delicate salmon pink rosé made naturally using selected copper skinned Pinot Grigio grapes. Delicate perfumed aromas of peach and rose petals and soft, red fruit flavours on the palate, dry and well balanced acidity.

Azabache Garnacha Rioja Rosado 2009

btl 15.50

Spain, Rioja, 14%, Dry

Bright strong pink in colour, its aroma has a great intensity of roses, strawberries and a slight hint of mandarin citrus. Smooth, lingering and long lasting taste with notable fruit and refreshing acidity.

Chateau de Fonscolombe Rose 2010

btl 19.50

French Regional, Provence- Coteaux d'Aix en Provence

Made by James de Roany on his estate just north of Aix, this traditional dry Provençal rose is made by the saignée method of 'bleeding' the fermenting juice from the skins to preserve delicacy and character. It is an elegant and dry with aromatic fruit aromas derived from a vibrant blend of Grenache, Cinsault, Counoise and Syrah

Mt Difficulty Pinot Noir Rose Estate Range 2010

New Zealand, Central Otago, 14.5%, Dry

If you have never tried a premium rose, this flavoursome wine made from the Pinot Noir grape is a great one to start with. Mouth watering flavours of strawberries and cream, delicious! Ask Ben at the bar!

La Playa `Late Harvest` Sauvignon Blanc 2007

btl 17.50 125ml 6.00

Chile, Colchagua Valley, 12%, Sweet

A dollop of perfumed Viognier adds fragrance and weight to this luscious white. Light golden in color with aromas of ripe citrus, melon, honey, quince, nutmeg and butterscotch. Sweet in the mouth, yet beautifully balanced with lingering fresh acidity.

Prosecco Raboso Rose Borgo del col Alto NV

Italy, Treviso, 11%

A delicate pink sparkling wine made from the Prosecco grape, grown in the fertile vineyards of northeast Italy in the region of Treviso. It is fragrant with summer fruit aromas, fresh and lively on the palate, dry, crisp and easy to drink.
